Any home learning situation also allows for a focus on review work! This email follows the communication of the 17th March. The "6 Strategies" booklet is a document to 'get to know' well. And we have covered almost two terms of material this year available to review.

Retrieval practice is the key method: students self-testing. Self-testing can be as simple as covering up information, attempting to write down the information from memory, then checking against the original information.

Basically retrieval practice is calling back to mind knowledge; generating knowledge of current and previous topics.

Students can self-test using notes in their exercise book, or resources specifically given to them for self-testing by their teacher this year e.g. booklets / or use of Seneca
