Note: by intervention we mean class technique / strategy / approach, not additional sessions / lessons

What is my inquiry question?

Of the format: What impact does [what practice?] delivered [over how long?] have on [what outcome?] for [whom?]?

What pre and post test will give me the most useful results?

e.g. use of existing topic tests, pupil surveys, specific MCQs or extended writing tasks.

What control factors will best ensure that my inquiry is 'disciplined'?

Can 'matched group' or 'randomised allocation' be used to quantify analysis?

What are the limitations and obstacles that may impede my enquiry?

What support will I need from colleagues?

e.g. Additional training, peer work scrutiny, peer reflection on IRIS recording, help with data analysis, assistance with a research review
