

Important Covid-19 Information Update - please read carefully

Dear Parents, Carers, Students, Staff and Friends of the School,

End of term and term dates remain unchanged

The Department for Education (DfE) announced that schools are permitted to make Friday 18th December a 'non-teaching' day. We will <u>not</u> be amending our term dates or our scheduled INSET days. Our last day of term for pupils will remain, Friday 18th December, 1.30pm.

Corona Virus cases and alerting the school over Christmas break

This table summarises the approach on Corona virus cases over Christmas in line with DFE guidance:

In order to ensure these arrangements work effectively and minimise the risk of compromising families' Christmas break, please adhere to the following:

- Parents seek tests via testing centres rather than via postal tests as this can significantly delay confirmation of results. Results are normally forthcoming in 24 hours via test centres.
- Parents notify school if children have symptoms after schools close (as outlined above) even when waiting for a test result, families can be advised to take necessary steps whilst awaiting confirmation.
- To minimise the risk of infection within school (and the wider community) please ensure you continue to adhere to social distancing protocol.
