
All year groups Parent and Pupil survey – results summary 1st Feb 2021




Questions regarding overall strategy

Is the amount of work being set for remote learning the right amount? 177 responses




The school's blend of live sessions and google classroom set activities gives me the degree of flexibility I need, whilst working at home




I am managing my working week by following my school timetable as of I were in school, as recommended by the school




The google classroom work and live sessions follow on from each other, rather than being two standalone things






I feel that I get the extra help I need from the school, when the blend of live sessions and google classroom set activities isn't working for me




At least some of the weekly remote learning I do can be done without screen time 177 responses




Questions about the 'live' (zoom) element of the remote teaching

I found it easy to look up my 'zoom timetable' using the Bromcom student portal 177 responses




Links to live zoom lessons are easy to find and are placed on the google classrooms well in advance of the lesson.




I have found connecting to and participating in live sessions was straightforward, in terms of the technology involved




I find live sessions helpful



I had made use of the recordings of live sessions, to revisit things I needed to hear again 177 responses




I had made use of the recordings of live sessions, because I struggle to attend all live session and use the recordings to catch up 177 responses






Questions about the Google classroom element of the remote teaching

Is the work being set at the right level of challenge? 177 responses




Any new learning via google classroom is effectively explained by my teachers (e.g. using videos, slides or other)






