On Sat 2nd Jan, we took the decision to temporarily offer Year 11 and 13 zoom 'drop-in' sessions covering their full teaching timetable, on top of the zoom timetable for 'live planned lessons' which we devised last term and consulted parents and teaching unions on.

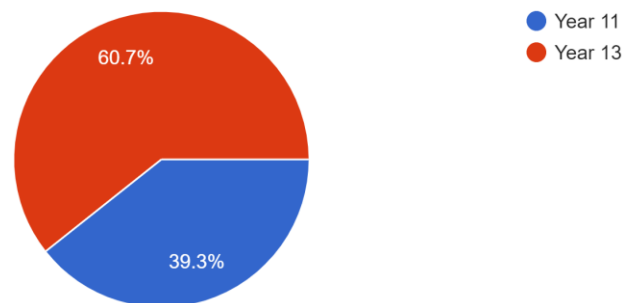

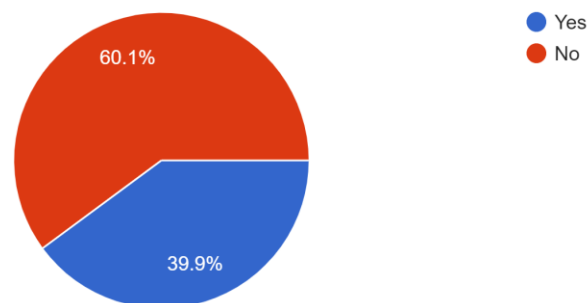

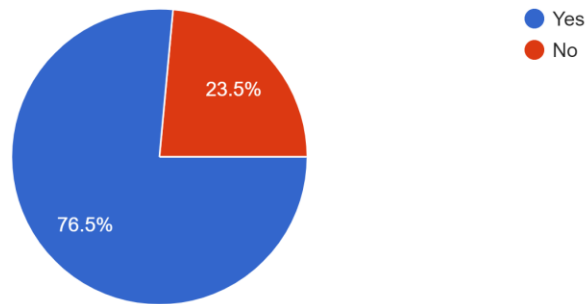
Have you used zoom drop-in sessions for any of your subjects?

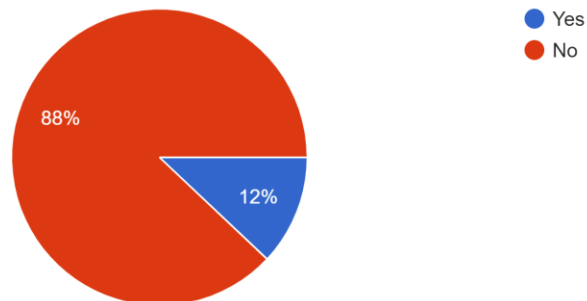
If you become stuck with your google classroom work, how do you prefer to communicate with your teacher? [assuming that you have the choice of one rather than all]
