## PARENT GOVERNORS (voluntary post)

We are looking to recruit a Parent Governor to join our Local Governing Body. Parent Governors are elected by Parents and Carers, and have a four year term of office. Parent Governors do not need to be practising Roman Catholics - the position is open to anyone who is a parent or a carer of any of the pupils at Notre Dame.

The governing body operates at a strategic level. Governors hold the Head of School and Leadership Team to account, oversee the financial performance of the school, manage the school's admission criteria and help recruit senior leadership.

Each Governor attends four full Governor meetings a year and up to six committee meetings. High quality training is provided. During the current pandemic, all Governors' meetings are held by live video link.

We are particularly keen to recruit people with knowledge and experience of human resources, finance, management as well as education.
