
03/03/23 Dear Parents, Carers, Students, Staff and Friends of the School

For the first time in 4 years we have been able to come together as a community and begin the period of lent together. Over 1000 students and 200 staff entered the sports hall in respectful silence as Fr Sean led us through the **Ash Wednesday liturgy**. It was a humbling experience. Fr Sean reminded pupils and staff that lent is a period of reflection, self-sacrifice but crucially, giving to others. We held the people of Syria and Turkey in our prayers. As ever, I was very proud of the students and the manner in which they conducted themselves.

A number of students suggested ways that we could raise money to support the earthquake relief efforts in Syria and Turkey. Our Y11 Prefects did a bucket collection during a registration and **raised £745** in only 15 mins! We are also looking forward to the cake sale being organised by a group of year 10 pupils with the support of the RE Dept.



Later in the term, all students will be offered the opportunity to receive the **Sacrament of Reconciliation** in the Chapel with Fr Sean.

This is a wonderful opportunity for our young people to reflect on those aspects of their life that they would like to improve.

We pray that lent will provide some peace during these turbulent times that we are living through.

National Careers Week 6th - 12th March




