# Courses and Predicted Grades

- You will need to input your predicted grades. These may have been supplied by your school or taken from a recent report.
- This page calculates the points total from your Best 8 Results. Use this as a guide to compare against our entry requirement of 42 points. You can still apply if your predicted grades are below 42 points. It's your actual GCSE exam grades that will count on enrolment day.
- On the courses page you can select 3 or 4 subjects to study at A-Level. You can change your A-Level choices later in the process through this section.
- Check our website ([www.ndhs.org.uk](http://www.ndhs.org.uk)) for specific entry requirements for each subject.
- We recommend that everyone applies to more than one school/college in case you need a back-up plan on GCSE results day.

# Things to remember

- You will need your parent's contact information (email address, phone numbers etc..) to complete your application.
- NDHS Sixth Form open evening takes place on **Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November 2023 between 5.30pm – 8.30pm**
- Applications close on **18<sup>th</sup> December 2023.**
