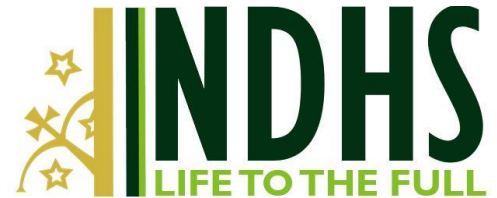

Staff and Friends of the School



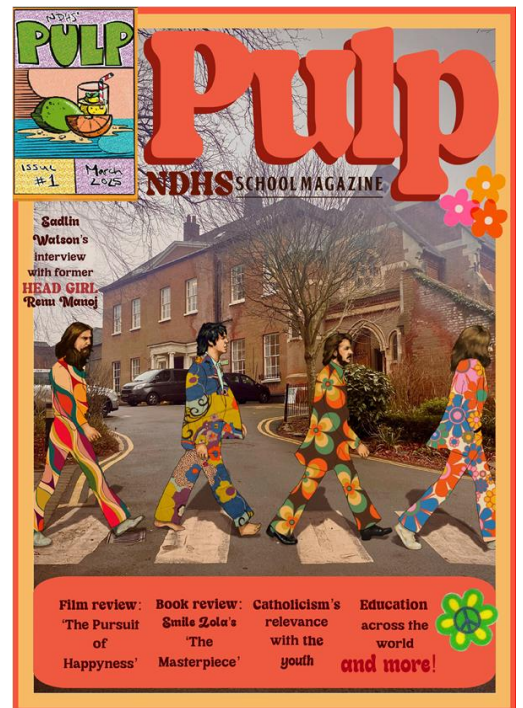
