Year 10

The Art and Design GCSE is 60% coursework (2 themed projects) and 40% Externally Set Assignment (set by the exam board and done under 10 hours exam conditions). Throughout the 2 years students are working on the 2 coursework projects. These projects consist of Developing Ideas, Recording, Exploring Media and Final Outcomes. Students complete a mock exam in the summer of year 10.

The grade used for the report is generated by a running teacher assessment tracked in student sketchbooks, the mock exam and the assessment at the end of the first coursework project.

Year 11

The Art and Design GCSE is 60% coursework (2 themed projects) and 40% Externally Set Assignment (set by the exam board and done under 10 hours exam conditions). Throughout year 11 students continue their coursework. These projects consist of Developing Ideas, Recording, Exploring Media and Final Outcomes. Students complete a mock exam in the December of year 11.

The grade used for the report is generated by a running teacher assessment tracked in student sketchbooks, the mock exam and the assessment at the end of the second coursework project.

Year 12

The Fine Art A Level is 60% coursework and 40% Externally Set Assignment (set by the exam board and done under 15 hours exam conditions - summer of year 13). Throughout year 12 students will complete a Personal Study coursework project, consisting of Developing Ideas, Recording, Exploring Media and Final Outcomes. Students complete a mock exam in the summer of year 12.

The grade used for the report is generated by a running teacher assessment tracked in student sketchbooks, key assessments at points during the project and the mock exam

Year 13

The Fine Art A Level is 60% coursework and 40% Externally Set Assignment (set by the exam board and done under 15 hours exam conditions - summer of year 13). Throughout year 13 students will continue their Personal Study coursework project, consisting of Developing Ideas, Recording, Exploring Media and Final Outcomes.

The grade used for the report is generated by a running teacher assessment tracked in student sketchbooks, and the assessment at key points during the project
