

Tier 1 – Teaching

- A broad & balanced curriculum
- Prioritising professional development of staff and use of coaching approaches
- Focus on quality first teaching; embedding research informed practices
- Evidence based disciplined inquiry programme to improve teaching and learning
- Development of metacognitive, memory and literacy strategies in the classroom – with access to specialist teacher training
- ‘PP First’ approach in the classroom
- Boosting capacity of Maths and English Teaching
- Monitoring of student progress through data tracking to inform responsive teaching
- Intelligent grouping and setting
- Developing cultural capital through curriculum enrichment and careers opportunities

Tier 2 – Targeted academic support

- Funding of Progress Tutor Team to deliver catch up interventions in English and Maths
- Purchasing of revision resources
- Provision of extra revision support sessions
 - Diagnostic testing to identify specific student barriers and interventions to address their individual needs



Tier 3 - Wider strategies
