Geography Department Supplementary Notes

- i. Alternate revision sessions once a week from post February half term – Thursday lunch then Thursday after school (as above).
- ii. Practice Questions once a fortnight completed as homework from Geography 360 practice questions booklet. 'Sample marking' [whereby a sample of questions are marked (5) & whole class self-assessment, feed-back and re-drafting will take place.
- iii. Google classroom access for all students e.g. past papers and revision materials uploaded for access to all. 3 specimen papers including mark schemes and mock exam paper.
- iv. All students have a Seneca Learning account and will be expected to use this – set as homework. Monitored by class teachers. Some use in class on chromebooks.
- v. Class teachers to hold one-2-one sessions with key students as required.
- vi. Lessons (1 a week minimum) will start with core 5 retrieval practice questions to support revision (this continues and is ongoing)
- vii. Department revision materials issued. All students should have CGP revision guide. They will also be given a Key terms guide, Case Studies Guide and Fieldwork revision guide.
- viii. All course content completed by 2 weeks before May ½ term at the latest to enable revision and exam preparation. This will include a minimum of 4 lessons linked to the Paper 3 Geographical Applications pre-release material.
- ix. CGP revision guides given to all PP students.
