In response to COVID and the resulting new way of working this programme will be a blended experience, with both a virtual and a physical experience (where available), giving you an insight into the future way of working

The programme will be run virtually for 4 days, where students can gain insight in to the different roles and functions across HSBC, as well as improving their personal and employability skills

Where physical placements are available, the student will spend the day within a function getting hands-on experience of what it is like working for HSBC. These physical placements will be available across different functions of the bank across the UK
