

### The HOW of Assessment

There are 6 formal Tests for each year group other than year 11 where there are only four. These exams take place roughly every 6 weeks.

In year 8 to 11 an average grade for the six most recent exams is tracked and this is the grade that will appear on each student's report.

In year 7 we use all the available results to give the student's average grade and this is the grade that will appear on each student's report.

The running average grade allows for a smoother way to track progress for each student.
